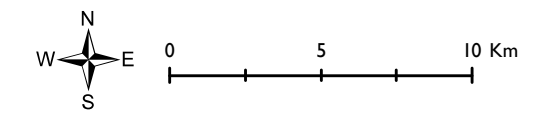
Figure 3.2: Draft Devon Landscape Character Areas overlaid onto Torridge Landscape Character Types
