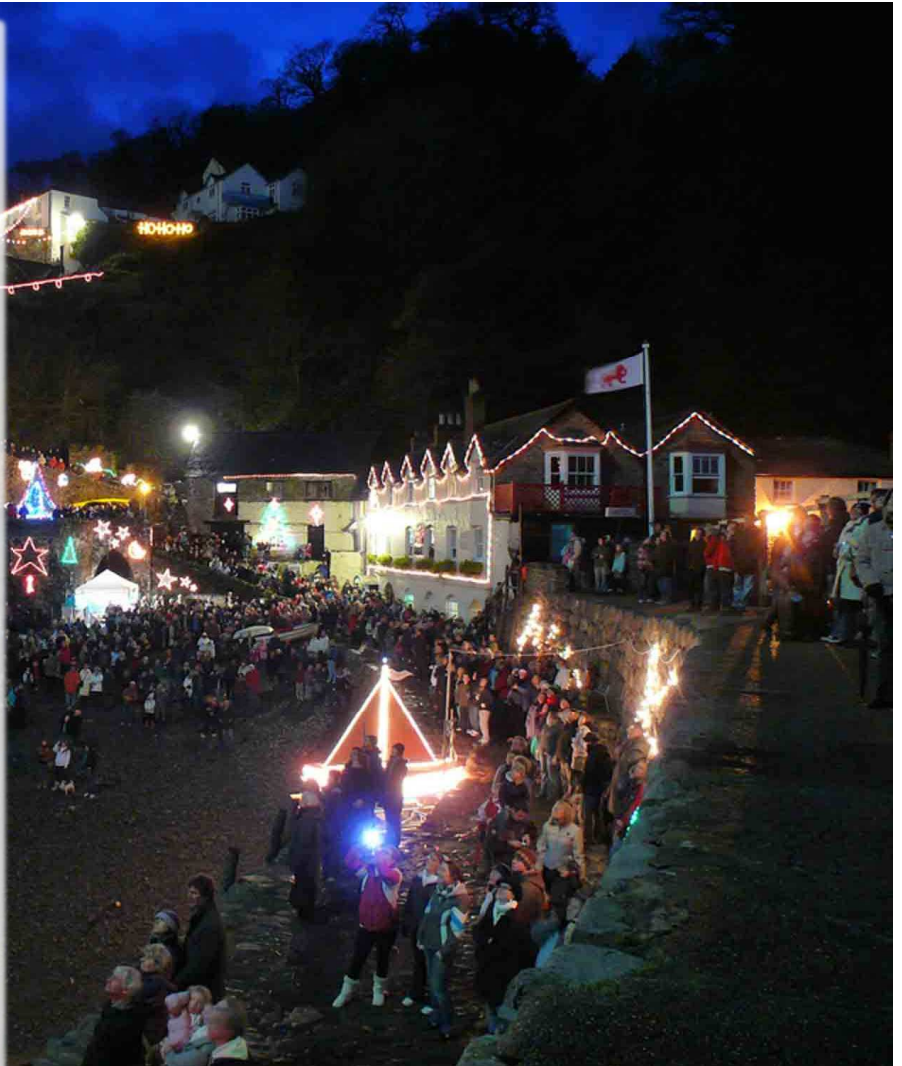

Indices of Deprivation

The Indices of Deprivation 2010 provide a relative measure of deprivation in small areas across England. It is based on the concept that deprivation consists of more than just poverty. Poverty is not having enough money to get by on where as deprivation refers to a general lack of resources and opportunities. The most widely used of these is the Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) which is a combination of a number of the other indices to give an overall score for the relative level of multiple deprivation experienced in every neighbourhood in England.

England has been divided into 32,482 areas each having roughly the same number of people. These are known as Lower Layer Super Output Areas¹ (LSOAs) and are a standard way of dividing up England and Wales. Like previous versions of the English Indices of Deprivation, a deprivation score has been calculated for each Lower layer Super Output Area in England. By using these small areas it is possible to identify small pockets of deprivation.

The overall Index of Multiple Deprivation 2010 shows Torridge ranked as the 101st (out of 354) most deprived local authority area in England, the most deprived of the Devon districts.
