

## Scoring guidance

Aim and description of the project	(Max.30pts)	30 points would mean an application has provided strong evidence of a lasting legacy; it is very detailed in its definition of how it is of benefit to the community and will complete with time frames given.
Evidence/ known potential of growth in parish	(Max.10pts)	10 points would be given where there is clear detailed numerical information provided. Also taking into account percentage increases of population relative to that ward.
Any volunteering hours – Number of hours logged and number of individuals	(Max.20pts)	Scale of 1-100+ hours to determine the weighting.
Strategic aims met & Which ones and how?	(Max.10pts)	Must meet at least one of the aims. The more aims met and the more detail provided, the higher the scoring.
<b>Extra weighting</b>		
Match funding details; (amount, source and current position with obtaining)	(Max.10pts)	The more funding achieved or reserved, the higher the scoring. Would score 10 points for equal funding or more in place.
Wider impact of project beyond parish or town.	(Max.10pts)	Scoring based on the number of individuals reached and the number of wards/boundaries crossed.
Evidence of support across organisations and or parish boundaries (please provide separately if necessary)	(Max.10pts)	Scoring based on the detail and level of evidenced support provided.
